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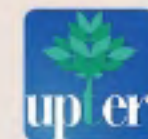

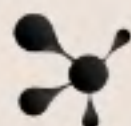

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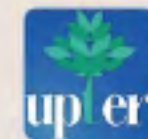


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Concluding our collaboration with IPEAH in the city of Rome, it seemed particularly significant to unite it with the events of 1943, which saw the deportation of the Roman Jews, focusing well on the issues of racism and discrimination, with contempt for human rights.

Our program and project aims to be in company with the Memorial Day of January 27 — in which ceremonies, initiatives, meetings and common moments of narration of facts and reflection, especially in schools of all levels, on what has happened to the Jewish people and to the Italian military and political deportees in the Nazi camps, in order to preserve the memory of a tragic and dark period of history in Europe, and ensure that such events never happen again.

Developed by young Czechs and funded by the CEE, **IPEAH** is shared by partner countries: Czech Republic (Institut Ludkych Prav); Hungary, (United for Intercultural Action); and Italy (SOS Racism Italy), allowing for widened boundaries of participation by other countries, such as France and Turkey.

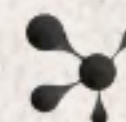
